

## LTC-2 Guard cover safety notice

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**WARNING:** personal injury may occur-**Do not disregard.**

To provide maximum safety for the operator, the opening on the guard needs to be as small as possible. For crimp tools that work with small terminals guards are provided that have a pre-cut slot. For crimp tools that work with large terminals, guard **LT2-ECPC01** is provided. This guard does not have any openings pre-cut into it. It is the owner's responsibility to drill/file a hole that is only large enough to allow the terminal to enter and exit the tooling. This opening should not be so large as to allow a small finger to enter the opening. An 8mm maximum diameter or slot width is recommended. If the crimp tool has more than one crimping position and it is the intent to use these multiple openings, care must be taken not to create an opening that is so large that a small finger can enter. If it is not possible to create such an opening then multiple guard covers should be created for this crimp tool. Each guard cover would then have a single opening for the desired crimp position in the tool.

To find the center of the cutout to be made, close the crimp tool and mark the center of the tool location.
